Medication Information

Please avoid any prolonged immobilization such as long airline flights before or after surgery. For, travelers, frequent ambulation every hour will decrease risk for blood clots during necessary travel. Two to three weeks prior and two to three weeks after your surgery, please discontinue any blood thinning products that you may be taking. The following is a list of some of the most commonly taken drugs that are blood thinners. It is not a complete list, so please read all labels of ingredients on anything that you may take. All patients undergoing elective surgical procedures lasting longer than 1 hour should stop birth control pills or female hormone replacement therapy 3 weeks before surgery if possible and OK with your Gynecologist. Hormonal therapy may increase your risk for blood clots. Please ask Dr. Brown if you have any questions regarding your need to stop hormonal therapy.
